REPORTS – Standing Committees

- **Finance Council** – Per Father Kelley, met last evening. Offertory was \$10k less than budgeted, expenses less than budgeted by \$10k. We will be receiving \$6k from Sherwin Williams for the paint on the rectory, 10k replacement cost, carnival to replace siding. Annual appeal \$100k goal was exceeded. Did a mailing this year. \$124,581 received. Next year bump in goal. 18% of parishioners participated, typical with envelopes. Budget ready to sign and send to the diocese. Personnel changes, Mark Winterbottom resigned as Youth Minister. Teaching full-time at St. Elizabeth's and will continue with confirmation program. Will replace in a few months. Waiting on head at diocese to be replaced. Youth ministry attendance low, need to look at model. Nathan resigned as assistant music director and St. Andrews. Moving to California. Lauren will be coming back to replace Nathan. Vince at St. Rose is retiring. Bob Altmiller to take over position and maintenance as well as St. Joseph.
- **Liturgy** – Per Tom Kohl, short meeting, social for Nat. St. Francis organ not working, two panels not working need to have someone look at it. EM procedure to change.
- **Christian Formation** – Per Mark Winterbottom, to meet next week. Religious education for summer started, 3 sessions. RCIA, possible 4 candidates.
- **Parish & Family Life** – Carnival coming up.
- **Social Concerns** – few people St. Vincent De Paul requests. Working with Toni to have a representative from the Hispanic community.
- **Building and Maintenance** – No report
